



# Transportation Options for NABC Tournament

**Good Old-Fashioned Ride Sharing** – Carpool with friends to share parking and driving costs.

## **Uber Group Options**

**Group Rides (Split Fare):** Uber allows you to set up a group ride in the app, invite friends, and add their pickup/drop-off spots. This feature allows you to split the cost equally directly in the app.

**UberXL / UberXXL:** For private, non-shared rides, these options accommodate up to 6 passengers (or more for special services like Uber Van).

## **Lyft Group Options**

**Lyft XL / XXL:** These options are designed for larger groups, with XL accommodating up to 6 passengers and XXL providing extra room for luggage.

**Event Rides:** Lyft allows you to create a unique code for events to help guests get to and from a location, which can be used for group coordination.

## **Public Transportation using Light Rail and Buses**

### **Green Line train/bus from St. Paul, Blue line buses from Minneapolis/Bloomington**

You can travel with Metro Transit, but light rail is under construction during July.

**From St. Paul.** Metro transit offers an express bus (94) from St. Paul Union Station to downtown Minneapolis to Government Plaza/Nicollet Mall stops.

#### **From Minneapolis/Bloomington.**

We do not recommend the Blue Line route since no trains are running during July.

Assuming you come by bus to the Nicollet Mall or Government Plaza stations it is about a 10 block walk to the Convention Center. If that is too long a walk for you, you can take the free bus that runs on Nicollet Mall to the Convention Center as noted below.

**Take Free Nicollet Mall Circulator Bus to Convention Center. The buses are marked “Free Ride”.**

**Optionally, for 50 cents you can ride the number 10 bus anywhere in the Minneapolis Downtown Zone.**
